On 29 April 2019, His Honour Judge Vavrecka

sitting at the County Court at Watford, Cassiobury House, 11/19 Station Road, Watford, WD17 1EZ read the order made on 5 October 2018, the affidavits of Nicholas John Edwards sworn on 14 December 2018 respectively as to service of the order and as to the provision of travelling expenses and the certificate dated 3 April 2019 of the Court Officer.

and the court is satisfied that

1. Edward Charles Lamb was ordered to attend court on 3 April 2019 to be questioned.
2. the order to attend was served on Edward Charles Lamb on 9 January 2019.
3. Edward Charles Lamb did not within seven days of the service of the order request from the judgment creditor payment of a sufficient sum for travelling expenses.
4. Edward Charles Lamb did not attend court on 3 April 2019 to be questioned.

And that Edward Charles Lamb has been guilty of contempt of court by disobeying the order of 9 January 2019

and the court orders that Edward Charles Lamb, 11 Belsize Close, St Albans, Herts, AL4 9YD be committed to Her Majesty's Prison The Mount for a period of 14 days

1. this order shall be suspended so long as Edward Charles Lamb attends court at 10:00 AM on 25 September 2019 at the County Court at Watford, Cassiobury House, 11/19 Station Road, Watford, WD17 1EZ and complies with the order made on 5 October 2018.
2. if Edward Charles Lamb does not comply with these terms, a warrant of arrest shall be issued and Edward Charles Lamb shall, when arrested, be brought before a judge to consider whether the committal order should be discharged.
